## **Basic questions you may have:**

## What happens during band camp?

I need both the signed formed and fee to provide the student with an instrument. Please do this before band camp and return the contract to me. Thank you!

## Important items for camp:

- Water Jug Please stay hydrated!
- Gym shoes/Tennis shoes Closed toe, No flip-flops/sandals, heels, or shoes with a high ankle. Improper shoes will prevent you from marching properly and could result in injury.
- Sunscreen
- Comfortable clothing for outdoors, must be school appropriate (t-shirt covers the stomach, shorts/pants worn at the waist, shorts reach the top of the knee, no leggings)
- Lunch if not leaving the school during the lunch break
- Instrument/Sticks
- Extra Reeds/Valve Oil items to keep your instrument playable throughout the day/week
- Music
- Pencil
- Hat/Sunglasses
